EN009 Cllr York gave a report on a recent presentation to One Barnstaple on a project called Grow, Share Cook. It is a Plymouth based project for

households on lower incomes and those at risk of Type-2 diabetes. The aim is to improve healthy eating and cookery skills by supplying fortnightly bags of 5 different seasonal fruits and vegetables which are sourced direct from growers and community growing projects, recipients also take part in cookery sessions designed to widen cookery knowledge. More details of the group can be found on the tamargrowlocal.org website. The intention is to explore options to see whether a similar project could be tried in Barnstaple.
